Excellent Admiral

With great pleasure the Government received your honourable letter dated 11/23 march in which is enclosed the copy of the answers of your excellence to the Plenipotentiaries at Hermione and the Primates of Hydra & Spetzies. Therefore, considering by that chance your noble opinions & your ardent zeal for the progress & amelioration of the affairs of Greece, from which it rightfully hopes in the happiest results.

The government well knows the necessity of joining the deputations & it doubts not at all that the only salvation for the country in the present important moment is in common agreement & harmony, & for the same reason, since it has been for so long a time removed him to Egina for the only end to act nearer for all that regards the safety of Athenian danger regarding with sorrow the division of the plenipotentiaries of the National Assembly implored by means to execute the desired agreement.

For this purpose, several messages have been sent to Hermione to persuade the plenipotentiaries there to consent in an agreement & then to choose jointly a place for the convocation of the National Assembly. For this purpose, yesterday another commission was sent there, as you know, to effect this reconciliation as the interests of the country require. In the meanwhile, the Government relies thoroughly on the cooperation of your excellency & that of Gen. Church. Be assured, your exc. that all the plenipotentiaries here are disposed to approve of all that regards the reconciliation.

Three members of the gov. will call on you to speak with your exc. about all that you require, according to the list you sent.

A translation of your commission is enclosed to you counter certified by the general secretary.
