#### Orders

1. that Lord Cochrane is appointed First commander of the Fleet & all the maritime Forces of Greece.
2. that he will be considered as superior to all commanders of the naval squadron having the rights of reprimand ~~to reprimand~~ as the rank of First Commander requires. He will enjoy all the honours, paces, privileges, insights which directly belong to him
3. that the commanders of the Fleet & all the seamen & all the officers of the navy are obliged to recognize him as such, & all the officers & soldiers who serve in the navy are bound to be subordinate to him, to obey & to execute his orders in all that concerns the ~~navy~~ of the nation. All the subordinate ranks of the government, whether civilian or military are bound to show ~~offer to~~ him proper resound respect.
4. ~~Prepared~~ secretaries will execute the print order in all respects, while the admiral Cochrane shall take the oath to execute the duties in power of which he is pleaded to ~~move~~ & to act
