Then the absolute necessity of coming back to Corinth. The mass of soldiers which the disturbances of Napoli have brought together here - The fact is that had the permanent conducted they ought to have done / having done necessity the contrary, the inhabitants would have had [] us immediately & order would have been established as far as possible. I have a great deal to say to you my dear Lord, & many things which I cannot write straightforward that main... a lot Zaimi (formed themselves into a kind of Commission) are gone to speak with your Lordship on business. What I have to say to you I will reserve until I have the Pleasure of seeing you & you will let me know where I can find your [] to meet you where you please.
