Hellas Poros 26 August 1827

Sir

I have now means to fulfil the conditional promise, I made to lend a thousand talari for the payment of the regular troops, and as I am about to proceed to Spezzia, I have requested to Dr. Gosse to do me the Service of remitting them to you.

Circumstances have occurred since I saw you which render the plan we held in view improper to be undertaken at the present moment, and I have to add that a desire to prevent words in a foreign language from being mistaken or hastily interpreted renders it essential that we shall hence forth contribute, each in his own way, towards the interests of that cause in which you have so long and gloriously interfered.
